The standardized test we are using —**New Linguaskill**—offers a reliable way to certify your English language skills across four areas: **Speaking, Writing, Reading and Listening**.

You'll receive an **official certificate** from Cambridge University Press & Assessment, which you can use as formal recognition of your English level.

What you need to know:

- **Testing period?** Select dates **15-27 October 2025**
(Exact date to be confirmed after registration)
- **Who?** You MUST be a Brazilian professor who has taught your university class through English¹.
- **Where?** Online, using a PC and the New Linguaskill remote testing platform
- **Cost?** None (the normal fee is ≈ EUR150)
- **Why?** A great opportunity to validate your English skills and boost your professional profile
- **What happens with my result?** Your individual test score will not be disclosed outside the research group.

The data collected through this English proficiency testing will be used for research purposes. Further information, including information about how we will handle your personal information, will be supplied later.
